In the Eastern Church, it is the commemoration of the baptism of Christ. The liturgical season of Epiphanytide runs from Epiphany Day until Septuagesima Sunday, which is:



-in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Denmark, three Sundays before Shrove Tuesday; ---in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, from Epiphany Day until the day before Ash Wednesday.



in NE Minneapolis. They buy bed frames and mattresses with donation money. Then people like us donate new sheets, blankets, pillows, protectors, and stuffed animals. Most of the children and young people are coming out of homelessness so they are often sleeping on the floor, a couch or an air mattress. They really do not have beds of their own! After getting one, the effects are life-changing. They sleep better and even do better in school. Children are recommended by schools or social service groups.

-twin mattress protectors

-twin blankets or comforters -smaller sized stuffed animals
