Dear People of Galilee,

According to the model constitution of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, when a pastor resigns or retires, an interim pastor receives an appointment with the consent of the Bishop of the synod and with the congregation or the Congregation Council. The Galilee Congregation Council voted to consent or appoint me as the interim pastor. The St. Paul Area Synod issued me a call as the appointed interim pastor for Galilee. As interim pastor, I have all the rights and duties of a regularly called pastor and I am not available for a regular or settled call to Galilee Lutheran.

During this period of transition, the Galilee Call Committee will move forward in completing a document called the Ministry Site Profile (MSP). This document allows the congregation to introduce itself to the synod staff who recommends to the Call Committee pastors who prayerfully consider themselves as candidates interested in this call of God at Galilee. The MSP describes experiences and priorities that are heard as the call of the Triune God for mission and ministry at Galilee in the Roseville community that borders Maplewood and the north end of St. Paul. Ordained pastors as candidates for the call need this bigger picture of Galilee with some details that are reviewed, assessed, and claimed by this congregation. So, an example of a question that Galilee gets to ask itself in completing the Ministry Site Profile, is: "What is God up to in this place we occupy and how are we listening and responding?"

This mission and ministry work of completing the MSP is foundational for the congregation and the newly called pastor to begin their shared partnership in the gospel, and to respond to the activity of our Triune God in the congregation and community. It is my role as the interim pastor to accompany Galilee in completing the Ministry Site Profile. It is a review and assessment of priorities for mission and ministry. This document provides a description of the congregation's leadership needs to guide their ministry. In completing the MSP, the congregation is listening and looking for the Spirit of Christ in the call of the mission of God in seeking a pastor with the gifts in knowledge, skills, and abilities to complement this coming shared partnership in the gospel. I look forward to our transitional partnership in completing the ministry site profile.
